Close Reading

As we read, we will be summarizing, questioning, and making connections.

The first time we read, we should be trying to comprehend or understand what is being written.

We will be doing this through a couple of strategies.

The first is deconstructing the text.

Review

Deconstructing the Text

To deconstruct means to take apart into its smaller pieces. We can do this with a reading by identifying the:

- **Who**
- **What**
- **Where**
- **When**
- **Why**
- **How**

Mean

This is about interpretation

Describe what the text means.

Think about what makes you think that?

How do you know that?

Matter

What are the implications? (results or possible outcomes?)

Why does it matter to me or others?

Why is it important?
